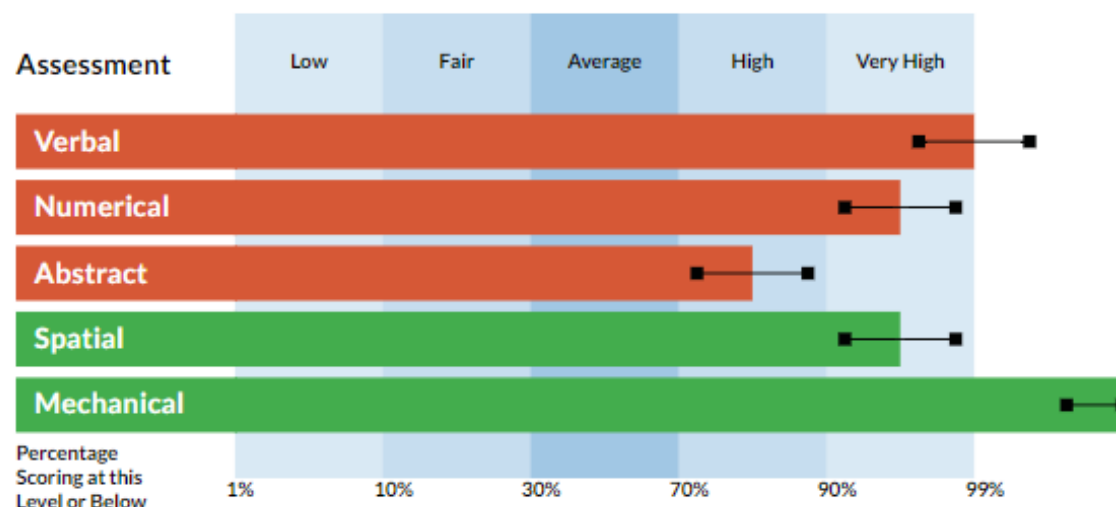

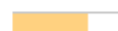

## Description

Actuaries make long term financial decisions in a range of areas; these may affect people in everyday life as well as the work of businesses, governments and financial organisations. They can work in pensions, insurance, banking, investment and healthcare.

The nature of their work is to apply financial, mathematical and statistical models to solve problems. They collect and analyse data of past events and assess current risks, carry out and interpret calculations and use the information gained to propose the best options to resolve the problem. Actuaries are able to explain complex financial issues in a clear manner; they have good presentation and communication skills. They are analytical with exceptional mathematical ability.

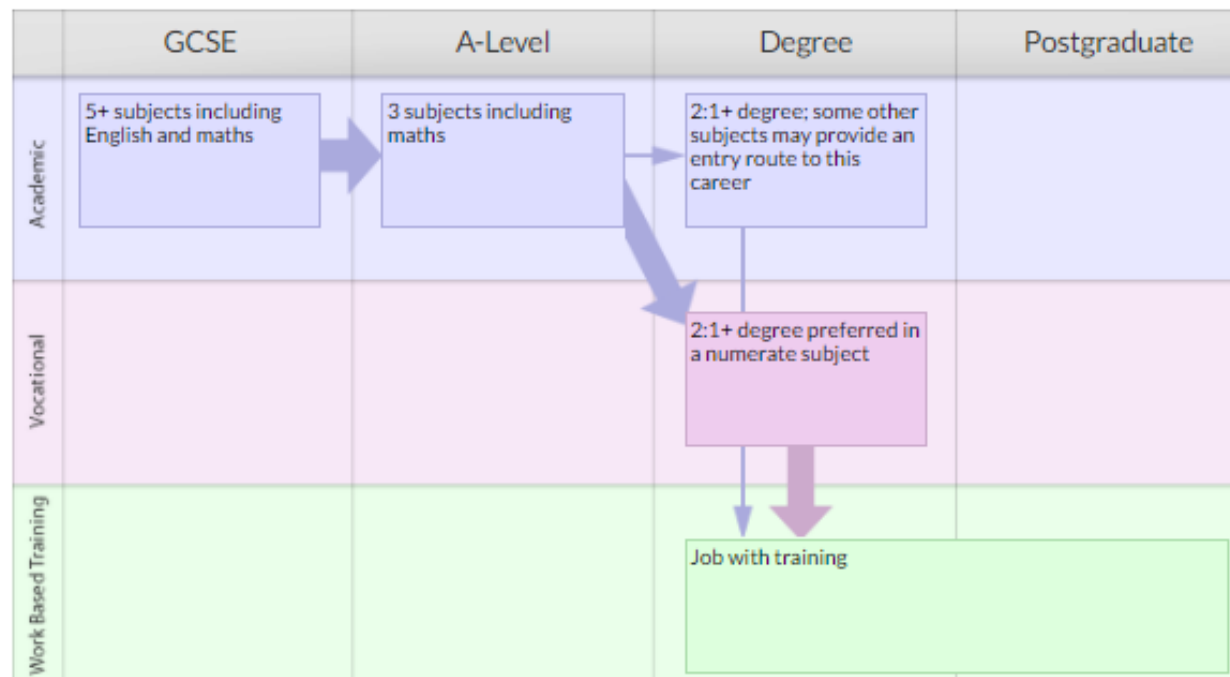

## How does it work?
